We are performing a statewide audit of the Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Courts. During our review of this court, we conducted certain audit procedures, as we deemed appropriate.

Management of this court is an important part of the court's accountability since you are responsible for establishing and maintaining internal controls and complying with applicable laws and regulations. During our review, we noted the following matter requiring management's attention and corrective action.

Properly Document Voided Transactions and Retain Voided Receipts:

Repeat: No

The Clerk does not properly document voided transactions and retain voided receipt copies. For five of eight voided receipts tested (63%), the Clerk did not retain all copies of the receipt and for three of the five, the Clerk did not have supporting documentation for the journal entries recording the voids.

Clerks must monitor and control voided transactions closely as they pose an increased risk for fraudulent activity. The Clerk should not void receipts without maintaining all copies of the receipt and supporting documentation. Additionally, the Clerk should properly train staff to perform appropriate journal entries rather than unnecessarily voiding receipt.
