We are performing a statewide audit of the Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Courts. During our review of this court, we conducted certain audit procedures, as we deemed appropriate.

Management of this court is an important part of the court's accountability, since you are responsible for establishing and maintaining internal controls and complying with applicable laws and regulations. During our review, we noted certain matters that required management's attention and corrective action. These matters included:

Properly Maintain Court Appointed Attorney Records

The former Clerk did not maintain court appointed attorney waivers and timesheets. Specifically, we tested 18 invoices and could not locate four waivers and three timesheets. A waiver provides a detailed explanation of additional fees requested. The timesheet provides a detailed accounting of the time spent on a case. We recommend the new Clerk hired in June 2012 implement procedures to help prevent this from reoccurring.
