We are performing a statewide audit of the General District Courts. During our review of this court, we conducted certain audit procedures, as we deemed appropriate.

Management of this court is an important part of the court's accountability, since you are responsible for establishing and maintaining internal controls and complying with applicable laws and regulations. During our review, we noted certain matters that required management's attention and corrective action. These matters included:

Properly Bill and Collect Court Fines and Costs

Repeat: Yes (first issued in fiscal year 2017)

The former Clerk did not properly bill and collect court fines and costs. In 39 cases tested, we noted the following errors.

- In eight cases, defendants were not charged a total of \$2,270 in fines and costs.
- In one locality case, attorney fees of \$120 were miscoded as town instead of county.

The Clerk should correct the specific cases noted above and should establish a system of review to minimize the likelihood of billing errors going undetected. In all cases, the Clerk should bill and collect court costs in accordance with Code of Virginia.
