We are performing a statewide audit of the General District Courts. During our review of this court, we conducted certain audit procedures, as we deemed appropriate.

Management of this court is an important part of the court's accountability, since you are responsible for establishing and maintaining internal controls and complying with applicable laws and regulations. During our review, we noted certain matters that required management's attention and corrective action. These matters included:

Reconcile Bank Account

The Clerk did not reconcile the court's bank account for six months of the audit period. Allowing reconciling items to go unresolved can lead to errors and irregularities going undetected and can increase the risk of loss of funds. Timely and complete reconciliations are an essential internal control.

The Clerk should perform monthly bank reconciliations upon receiving the bank statements as required by the <u>Financial Management System User's Guide</u>.
