We are performing a statewide audit of the Magistrates. During our review, we conducted certain audit procedures, as we deemed appropriate.

Management is an important part of the Magistrates' accountability, since you are responsible for establishing and maintaining internal controls and complying with applicable laws and regulations. During our review, we noted certain matters that required management's attention and corrective action. These matters included:

Properly Manage Magistrate Funds

- Magistrate Harrington delayed depositing cash bonds into her official bank account. Specifically we tested six receipts and noted three receipts totaling \$5,500 held one or more days before depositing the cash into her official bank account.
- Not depositing cash into the bank promptly is a risk which could lead to a loss of funds. We recommend the Magistrate deposit funds into the bank by the next business day as required by the Magistrate Manual.
