We are performing a statewide audit of the Magistrates. During our review, we conducted certain audit procedures, as we deemed appropriate.

Management is an important part of the Magistrates' accountability, since you are responsible for establishing and maintaining internal controls and complying with applicable laws and regulations. During our review, we noted certain matters that required management's attention and corrective action. These matters included:

Complete Monthly Bank Reconciliations

Ten of 11 magistrates did not complete their bank reconciliations and the Chief Magistrate does not review that these magistrates were performing their monthly bank reconciliations and resolving any reconciling items. The Supreme Court's <u>Magistrate Manual</u> requires that magistrates complete monthly bank reconciliation and resolve all reconciling items. The Chief Magistrate should periodically review the magistrates' reconciliations to determine if they are following the appropriate practices.
