We have performed procedures on the accompanying Statement of Assets and Liabilities of Michele B. McQuigg, former Clerk of the Circuit Court of the County of Prince William at February 16, 2017. The Clerk of the Circuit Court is an elected constitutional officer who administers the County of Prince William's court of record. All records supporting the amounts presented in this financial statement are the responsibility of the outgoing Clerk.

The purpose of the limited procedures we performed was to determine the accountability of the former Clerk at February 16, 2017, and to turn over the assets, accounts, and records of the office to Robert S. FitzSimmonds, III, the newly appointed Clerk of the Circuit Court. Our procedures included agreeing the amounts presented in the accompanying statement to supporting documentation, such as bank statements and financial reports. We also verified the termination of the former Clerk's access to financial and other systems and the Court's bank account. A more comprehensive audit of the former Clerk was performed for the period of July 1, 2015 through December 31, 2016, the results of which are included in our report dated March 16, 2017.

This financial statement has been prepared on the cash basis of accounting, which is a comprehensive basis of accounting other than generally accepted accounting principles. This basis of accounting is prescribed by the State Comptroller and approved by the Auditor of Public Accounts as it is deemed the appropriate method of reporting by Clerks of the Circuit Court.

Based on the procedures we performed, we found the financial statement referred to above was properly supported and presents fairly, in all material respects, the assets and liabilities of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of the County of Prince William as of February 16, 2017, on the cash basis of accounting described above.

We acknowledge the cooperation extended to us during this engagement.
