We are performing a statewide audit of the General District Courts. During our review of this court, we conducted certain audit procedures, as we deemed appropriate.

Management of this court is an important part of the court's accountability, since you are responsible for establishing and maintaining internal controls and complying with applicable laws and regulations. During our review, we noted certain matters that required management's attention and corrective action. These matters included:

Properly Bill Fines and Costs

The Clerk and her staff is not properly billing and collecting fines and public defender fees involving local and state charges resulting in a loss of revenue to the Commonwealth and locality. Auditor tested ten cases and noted the following errors in five of these cases.

- In two cases, the Clerk erroneously identified fines totaling \$350 and public defender fees totaling \$50 as local violations rather than state. Additionally, the Clerk improperly billed the locality for public defender fees totaling \$25.
- In two cases, the Clerk incorrectly over-charged the locality for public defender fees totaling \$105.
- In one local case, the Clerk's staff did not properly bill the locality for the public defender fees totaling \$30.

We recommend the Clerk research all similar cases, make the appropriate corrections to case paperwork, and bill the localities for the applicable public defender fees. The Clerk and her staff should work with the Office of the Executive Secretary to receive training, if necessary, regarding the processing of local and state charges.
