Local Government News and Updates

The annual Locality Data Surveys are now available for completion, available at apa.virginia.gov > Local Government > Comparative Report Resources > Annual Data Request Surveys
 The APA needs your assistance to ensure we have accurate information on file for the upcoming locality fiscal year 2025 audits and our Comparative Report and transmittal process.

To download a copy of your locality's FY2025 data survey (Excel workbook), navigate to the APA website <u>link</u> and filter/search by your locality name. You can refer to additional information about completing the Data Survey at <u>this email correspondence</u>. Please be sure to also submit a copy of your audit contract or engagement letter for the FY2025 audit, if your locality's survey form indicates that the APA does not have a copy on file. Please submit your completed survey by email to <u>localgovernment@apa.virginia.gov</u> by Friday, July 4, 2025.

Please keep in mind the statutory audit delay notification requirement if a locality has not completed its
FY2024 audit and financial report by the December 15 deadline and has not yet submitted this reporting to
the APA. The locality is required to publicly post the audit delay notification on its website and notify the
APA concerning the delay.

If your locality's estimated audit and financial report completion date has changed, the Code of Virginia requires the locality to continue to update the audit delay notification with any changes until the audit is complete. Please be sure to also notify the APA with any update on the expected date for submitting the locality's required FY2024 financial reporting to our office.



Update: Please note when you now access local government information from the Reports or Resources sections an automatic Year filter of '2022-2025' is applied to the search criteria, as this helps ensure a faster load time for the website. **Accordingly, you may need to first close this filter to find an applicable report or to see all available resources.** You can do so by clicking the x next to the '2022-2025' Year filter criteria. During February 2024, the APA launched a brand-new website platform; as such, all URL hyperlinks to local government resources have now changed. Please note that the URL hyperlinks for all local government reports and resources published on the APA website no longer contain apa.virginia.gov in the URL domain. The URL domain name now points to the Commonwealth agency Division of Legislative Automated Systems' (DLAS) data content and cloud-based web-hosting platforms (via Directus and Microsoft Azure), as DLAS is assisting our office with managing the APA website.

Note: If you are unable to see updated information/data in the various resource files when downloading from our website (e.g.: guidance documents, manuals, Cardinal reports), you may need to first clear your browser cache to remove prior versions of the files, then download the updated file again.

The **Resources** section of the Local Government website page includes important guidelines, manuals, and other helpful guidance, such as the Cardinal State Disbursement reports, the annual Audit Specifications, Uniform Financial Reporting Manual, and many other documents published and updated annually. This section also contains all files related to the Comparative Report Transmittal process, such as Transmittal preparation and training resources, the locality specific annual surveys, and the locality specific Transmittal workbooks.

All relevant guidelines, manuals, and other guidance documents are available by selecting the main *Guidelines and Manuals* category. You can search for the various types of resources under the *Find a Report* feature, and filtering by the 'Subcategories' menu. You can also search for a specific resource by typing a keyword in the *Filter by Title* search feature at the top of the documents listing.






Local Government-related reports are organized into two main categories: those issued by our office and those issued by external CPA firms.

The APA Reports section includes internally issued reports for local related audits, special projects, quality control reviews over CPA firms performing local government audits, and other areas. The Judicial Reports section now includes all APA issued reports for court/judicial audits, constitutional officer turnovers, and the results of audits over state funds held by constitutional officers.

Once navigating to one of the main *APA Reports* categories, you can search on various report types under the *Find a Report* feature, and filtering by the 'Subcategories' menu. You can also search for a specific locality report by filtering the 'Localities' menu or using the *Filter by Title* search feature at the top of the reports listing.







The Other Reports section includes financial related reports issued by external CPA firms for localities (cities, counties, and towns), along with other governmental entities that have submitted their annual audit reports to our office such as local authorities, boards, commissions, districts, and small towns that elect to have an audit. This section also includes reports for the judicial audits over certain Clerks of the Circuit Court and other audits over constitutional officers performed by an external CPA firm.

Once navigating to one of the main *Other Reports* categories, you can search on various report types under the *Find a Report* feature, and filtering by the 'Subcategories' menu. You can also search for a specific locality report by filtering the 'Localities' menu or using the *Filter by Title* search feature at the top of the reports listing.
