As part of our audit of the Virginia District Court System, we have audited the cash receipts and disbursements of the County of Orange District Court for the period January 1, 2003 through March 31, 2004.

Our primary objectives were to test the accuracy of financial transactions recorded on the Court's financial management system; evaluate the Court's internal controls; and test its compliance with significant state laws, regulations, and policies. However, our audit was more limited than would be necessary to provide assurance on the internal controls or on overall compliance with applicable laws, regulations, and policies.

The results of our tests found the Court properly stated, in all material respects, the amounts recorded and reported in the financial management system; and no material weaknesses in the internal controls. However, we noted noncompliance with state laws, regulations, and policies that the Clerk needs to address as described below.

Assess Proper Fines and Costs

In six of 20 cases tested, the Clerk did not assess the correct amount for the local jailing fee as required by local ordinance pursuant to Section 15.2-1613.1 of the <u>Code of Virginia</u>. Further, in three of 20 cases tested, the Clerk improperly assessed the \$50, Sentencing Fee, on fixed-fee misdemeanor cases, resulting in a \$50 overcharge for these three cases. The Clerk should ensure that staff assesses fees and costs in accordance with state law.

MAGISTRATE FINDING:

Retain Records

The Chief Magistrate did not recover the financial accounting records from Magistrate Dove before he left employment. Chapter X of the <u>Magistrate's Manual</u> requires chief

magistrates to secure the financial records from any magistrate leaving employment to prevent alteration or inappropriate destruction.

The Chief Magistrate should implement procedures to obtain the financial accounting records of any magistrate who is leaving employment. Further, the Chief Magistrate should request the return of the records from the above former magistrate in writing and advise him that, in accordance with Section 42.1-88 of the <u>Code of Virginia</u>, and he must return of the records within ten days of receiving written requests. Further, we recommend, that as the magistrate supervising authority, the Circuit Court Chief Judge require Chief Magistrate Thompson to obtain the records of former Magistrate Dove.

We discussed these comments with the Chief Judges on April 21, 2004 and we acknowledge the cooperation extended to us by the court during this engagement.
