We are performing a statewide audit of the General District Courts. During our review of this court, we conducted certain audit procedures, as we deemed appropriate.

Management of this court is an important part of the court's accountability, since you are responsible for establishing and maintaining internal controls and complying with applicable laws and regulations. During our review, we noted certain matters that required management's attention and corrective action. These matters included:

Properly Document Manual Receipt Activity – (Repeat)

The Clerk did not properly document manual receipt usage during the audit period. Specifically, four of 35 manual receipts tested were not dated. Failure to date manual receipts poses an increased risk for fraudulent activity, misappropriation of funds, and errors in recording manual activity in the court's financial system. We recommend the Clerk closely monitor all manual receipt activity to ensure receipts are properly dated.

We acknowledge the cooperation extended to us by the Court during this engagement.
