We are performing a statewide audit of the Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Courts. During our review of this court, we conducted certain audit procedures, as we deemed appropriate.

Management of this court is an important part of the court's accountability since you are responsible for establishing and maintaining internal controls and complying with applicable laws and regulations. During our review, we noted certain matters that required management's attention and corrective action. These matters include the following:

Request and Allocate Tax Set-Off Refunds

Repeat: No

The Clerk did not submit claims to the Virginia Department of Taxation (Taxation) for tax setoff of refunds for delinquent court fines and costs of \$395, resulting in a loss of revenue to the Commonwealth and locality. In addition, at June 30, 2020, the Clerk was holding \$4,181 in tax refunds that should have been allocated to defendants' accounts.

A court must submit claims for set-off of tax refunds through Taxation's automated accounting system and the Clerk should use the tax refund set-off process to maximize collections as required by the Code of Virginia. Upon receipt of the tax set-off funds, the Clerk should immediately allocate the amounts to the individual defendants' accounts.
