We are performing a statewide audit of the Magistrates. During our review, we conducted certain audit procedures, as we deemed appropriate.

Management is an important part of the Magistrates' accountability since you are responsible for establishing and maintaining internal controls and complying with applicable laws and regulations. During our review, we noted the following matter requiring management's attention and corrective action.

Follow Established Accounting Procedures

Repeat: No

The Chief Magistrate and her staff did not follow established accounting procedures, as outlined in the Office of the Executive Secretary's Magistrate Manual. We noted the following errors:

- The magistrates delayed depositing one bond into the magistrates' bank account but made the corresponding remittance to the applicable courts immediately, causing an overdraft of the magistrates' bank account.
- The magistrates did not obtain court receipts for three of the ten bonds tested (30%).
- The magistrates did not retain all copies of the receipt voided during the audit period.

Cash bonds are especially vulnerable to loss and misappropriation. The Chief Magistrate and her staff should consistently follow the accounting procedures outlined in the Magistrate Manual to properly monitor, control, and safeguard collections.
