COMMENTS TO MANAGEMENT

We noted the following matters involving internal control and its operation that has led or could lead to the loss of revenues, assets, or otherwise compromise the Clerk's fiscal accountability.

Properly Bill and Collect Court Costs

Repeat: Yes (first issued in fiscal year 2018)

The Clerk and her staff did not properly bill and collect court costs. In 29 cases tested, we noted the following errors:

- Defendants in seven cases were not billed \$2,083 in court costs.
- In one case, the defendant was overcharged \$445 in attorney fees.

The Clerk and her staff should correct the specific cases noted above and should establish a system of review to minimize the likelihood of billing errors going undetected. In all cases, the Clerk should bill and collect court costs in accordance with Code of Virginia.

Properly Monitor and Disburse Liabilities

Repeat: No

The Clerk does not properly monitor and disburse court liabilities. Specifically, the Clerk did not disburse four liability accounts totaling \$1,590 that should have been paid out during the audit period. The Clerk should disburse the amounts noted and should monitor and disburse liabilities on a monthly basis as recommended by the Financial Accounting User's Guide.

Properly Review General Ledger

Repeat: No

The Clerk does not properly review the Court's general ledger to ensure account balances are appropriate. As of March 2020, the Clerk was holding \$440 in tax refunds that should have been allocated to defendants' accounts. The Clerk should correct the current error and going forward should review the general ledger daily to ensure the propriety of all account balances.

We have audited the cash receipts and disbursements of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of this locality for the period noted above. Our primary objectives were to test the accuracy of financial transactions recorded on the Court's financial management system; evaluate the Court's internal controls; and test its compliance with significant state laws, regulations, and policies.

Management's Responsibility

Court management has responsibility for establishing and maintaining internal controls and complying with applicable laws and regulations. Internal control is a process designed to provide reasonable, but not absolute, assurance regarding the reliability of financial reporting, effectiveness and efficiency of operations, and compliance with applicable laws and regulations. Deficiencies in internal controls could possibly lead to the loss of revenues or assets, or otherwise compromise fiscal accountability.

We noted matters involving internal control and its operation necessary to bring to management's attention. These matters are discussed in the section titled <u>Comments to Management</u>. Any response and written corrective action plan to remediate these matters provided by the Clerk are included as an enclosure to this report.

We discussed these comments with the Clerk, and we acknowledge the cooperation extended to us by the Clerk and her staff during this engagement.
