We have audited the cash receipts and disbursements of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of the County of Charlotte for the period April 1, 2001 through March 31, 2002.

Our primary objectives were to test the accuracy of financial transactions recorded on the Court's financial management system; evaluate the Court's internal controls; and test its compliance with significant state laws, regulations, and policies. However, our audit was more limited than would be necessary to provide assurance on the internal controls or on overall compliance with applicable laws, regulations, and policies.

The results of our tests found the Court properly stated, in all material respects, the amounts recorded and reported in the financial management system; and no material weaknesses in the internal controls. However, we noted noncompliance with state laws, regulations, and policies that the Clerk needs to address as described below.

Reimburse Machine Recording Fund

The Clerk has improperly used the machine recording fees by disbursing the funds to the County for the installation of Internet access throughout the new clerk's office. Section 17.1-275.11(c) of the <u>Code of Virginia</u> allows courts that use electronic devices for recording testimony to assess a special machine-recording fee. The statute limits the fees use to repairing, replacing, or supplementing such electronic devices, or if a sufficient amount is available, to purchase such devices in whole or in part.

The Clerk should personally reimburse the machine recording fund \$8,859.17 for the improper disbursing of the funds unless the Clerk can get the County to reimburse for the equipment in accordance with Section 15.2-1656 of the Code of Virginia. After making the fund whole, the clerk should send all machine-recording fees to the Commonwealth.

We discussed these comments with the Clerk on July 19, 2002 and we acknowledge the cooperation extended to us by the court during this engagement.
