We are performing a statewide audit of the Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Courts. During our review of this court, we conducted certain audit procedures, as we deemed appropriate.

Management of this court is an important part of the court's accountability, since you are responsible for establishing and maintaining internal controls and complying with applicable laws and regulations. During our review we noted certain matters that required management's attention and corrective action. These matters included:

Request Tax Set-Off Refunds

The Clerk did not submit a claim to the Virginia Department of Taxation (TAX) for a tax set-off refund totaling \$313 for delinquent court costs and fines, resulting in a loss of revenue to the Commonwealth and locality. A court must submit claims for set-off of tax refunds through TAX's automated accounting system called the Integrated Revenue Management System. The Clerk should use the tax refund set off process to maximize collections as required by the Code of Virginia.
