Independent Accountants' Report

The Virginia Auditor of Public Accounts

We have examined the accompanying Statement of Assets and Liabilities of Gail P. Clayton of the Circuit Court of the County of Surry, Virginia, at December 29, 2023. We have also examined the accompanying supplemental schedules. The Clerk of the Circuit Court of the County of Surry, Virginia is responsible for the schedule and receipts in accordance with the criteria set forth in §58.1-3136 of the Code of Virginia. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on the Statement of Assets and Liabilities and the supplemental schedules based on our examination. We did not examine the Turnover Receipt of Uncollected State Taxes from Outgoing Treasurer to Incoming Treasurer. This schedule was examined by other accountants whose report has been furnished to us, and our opinion, insofar as it relates to the amount shown on these schedules, is based solely on the report of other accountants.

Our examination was conducted in accordance with attestation standards established by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants and the *Specifications for Audits of Counties, Cities, and Towns* issued by the Auditor of Public Accounts. Those standards require that we plan and perform the examination to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the Statement of Assets and Liabilities and supplemental schedules are in accordance with the criteria, in all material respects. An examination involves performing procedures to obtain evidence about the Statement of Assets and Liabilities and supplemental schedules. The nature, timing, and extent of the procedures selected depend on our judgment, including an assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statement and supplemental schedules, whether due to fraud or error. We believe that the evidence we obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a reasonable basis for our opinion.

We are required to be independent and to meet our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with relevant ethical requirements relating to the engagement.

§58.1-3136 of the Code of Virginia requires a turnover audit whenever a Clerk of the Circuit Court leaves office. 
