We are performing a statewide audit of the Combined District Courts. During our review of this court, we conducted certain audit procedures, as we deemed appropriate.

Management of this court is an important part of the court's accountability since you are responsible for establishing and maintaining internal controls and complying with applicable laws and regulations. During our review, we noted the following matter requiring management's attention and corrective action.

## **Properly Bill and Collect Attorney Fees**

Repeat: No

The Clerk and her staff did not properly bill and collect attorney fees. In two of five attorney invoices tested (40%), the Clerk overcharged defendants a total of \$174. The Clerk should correct the specific cases noted during the audit, seek additional training in the billing and collection of attorney fees, and establish a system of review to minimize the likelihood of billing errors going undetected. In all cases, the Clerk should bill and collect attorney fees in accordance with the Code of Virginia.
