We are performing a statewide audit of the Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Courts. During our review of this court, we conducted certain audit procedures, as we deemed appropriate.

Management of this court is an important part of the court's accountability, since you are responsible for establishing and maintaining internal controls and complying with applicable laws and regulations. During our review, we noted certain matters that required management's attention and corrective action. These matters included:

## Properly Bill and Collect Court Costs

In 10 of 41 cases tested, the Clerk did not bill the defendants for court-appointed attorney fees of \$981 and fixed misdemeanor fees of \$20. The Clerk should correct these specific cases. The Clerk should work with his staff to ensure they understand the billing and collecting requirements when the court hears cases involving court-appointed attorneys and public defenders and, if necessary, request additional training from the Office of the Executive Secretary of the Supreme Court of Virginia.
