In planning and performing our audit of the financial statements of the County of Middlesex, Virginia for the year ended June 30, 2016, we considered the County's internal control structure to plan our auditing procedures for the purpose of expressing our opinion on the financial statements and not to provide assurance on the internal controls of the County.

However, during our audit, we noted certain matters that are opportunities for strengthening internal controls and operating efficiencies. Said matters are not deemed to be material weaknesses or significant deficiencies in internal control. Further, this letter does not affect our report dated November 29, 2016 on the financial statements of the County of Middlesex, Virginia.

We have already discussed these comments and recommendations with appropriate members of management and we will review the status of these comments during our next audit engagement.

FY16 FUND BALANCE AVAILABLE FOR APPROPRIATION IN FY17

The unassigned fund balance of the General Fund at the end of FY16 was approximately \$8.9 million. The County's overall operating budget less fund transfers was \$26.0 million for FY16. RFC recommends the Board set aside 20% (slightly less than 2.5 months of cash flow) of its operating budget as an operating reserve that would automatically be committed to ongoing expenditures for FY17. If the 20% scenario was adopted by the Board, \$5.2 million of the unassigned fund balance would be held as an operating reserve and \$3.7 million would be available for appropriation in FY17.
