We are performing a statewide audit of the Combined District Courts. During our review of this court, we conducted certain audit procedures, as we deemed appropriate.

Management of this court is an important part of the court's accountability, since you are responsible for establishing and maintaining internal controls and complying with applicable laws and regulations. During our review, we noted certain matters that required management's attention and corrective action. These matters included:

## Repeat: No

In five of 41 cases tested, the Clerk and her staff did not enter the correct payment due dates in the automated system. If defendants cannot pay their fines and court costs within 30 days of sentencing, Code of Virginia § 19.2-354 requires a court order or payment agreement indicating the payment due dates for fines and costs. Improperly entering payment due dates on individual accounts in the automated system hinders collection efforts and could result in a loss of revenue to both the Commonwealth and the locality. The Clerk should enter the correct payment due dates in the automated system based on the applicable court order or signed payment agreement.
