We are performing a statewide audit of the General District Courts. During our review of this court, we conducted certain audit procedures, as we deemed appropriate.

Management of this court is an important part of the court's accountability, since you are responsible for establishing and maintaining internal controls and complying with applicable laws and regulations. During our review, we noted certain matters that required management's attention and corrective action. These matters included:

Properly Assess Attorney Costs

Repeat: No

The former Clerk did not have sufficient procedures in place to properly assess court-appointed attorney fees. In 45 cases tested, attorney fees were improperly assessed on two felony cases, not certified on four appealed cases, miscoded on one case, and allowable expenses not assessed on two cases, resulting in a total loss to the Commonwealth of \$1,259.

The current Clerk should correct the cases noted above and should establish a system of review to ensure all costs are properly assessed.
