We are performing a statewide audit of the Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Courts. During our review of this court, we conducted certain audit procedures, as we deemed appropriate.

Management of this court is an important part of the court's accountability, since you are responsible for establishing and maintaining internal controls and complying with applicable laws and regulations. During our review, we noted certain matters that required management's attention and corrective action. These matters included:

Properly Distribute Collections

The Clerk did not distribute \$216 in Tax Set-Off Program collections received from the Department of Taxation to individual accounts in the court's accounting system. Failure to distribute these funds results in incorrect balances on the applicable defendants' accounts. The Clerk should promptly update individual accounts when collections are received from the Tax Set-Off Program.
