1. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of Accounting

The financial statements of the General Receiver of the Circuit Court of the City of Alexandria have been prepared using the cash basis of accounting. Under the cash basis of accounting, revenues are recorded when received in cash and disbursements are recorded when made.

2. SURETY BOND

The General Receiver was bonded under a Trust Fund Administrators Bond with the Firemen's Insurance Company of Newark, New Jersey, as surety.
