We are performing a statewide audit of the Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Courts. During our review of this court, we conducted certain audit procedures, as we deemed appropriate.

Management of this court is an important part of the court's accountability since you are responsible for establishing and maintaining internal controls and complying with applicable laws and regulations. During our review, we noted the following matter requiring management's attention and corrective action.

## **Properly Bill and Collect Court Costs**

**Repeat:** Yes (first issued in fiscal year 2021)

The Clerk and her staff did not properly bill and collect court costs. In eight of 30 cases tested (27%), we noted the following errors.

- In three cases, the Clerk did not certify costs of \$2,850 to the circuit court.
- The Clerk did not charge defendants in four cases a total of \$480 in court costs.
- For one case the Clerk overcharged the defendant \$120 in court costs.
- The Clerk erroneously sent one attorney invoice for \$120 to the Commonwealth for payment instead of the locality.

The Clerk should correct the specific cases noted above, seek additional training in the billing and collection of court costs, and establish a system of review to minimize the likelihood of billing errors going undetected. In all cases, the Clerk should bill and collect court costs in accordance with the Code of Virginia.
