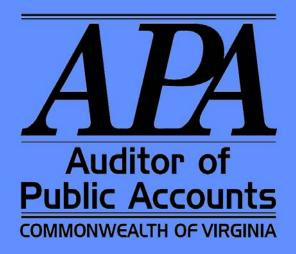

We have audited the cash receipts and disbursements of the Clerk of the Circuit Court for this Court System and for the period noted above. Our primary objectives were to test the accuracy of financial transactions recorded on the Court's financial management system; evaluate the Court's internal controls; and test its compliance with significant state laws, regulations, and policies.

Management's Responsibility

Court management has responsibility for establishing and maintaining internal controls and complying with applicable laws and regulations. Internal control is a process designed to provide reasonable, but not absolute, assurance regarding the reliability of financial reporting, effectiveness and efficiency of operations, and compliance with applicable laws and regulations. Deficiencies in internal controls could possibly lead to the loss of revenues or assets, or otherwise compromise fiscal accountability.

We noted a matter involving internal control and its operation necessary to bring to management's attention. The matter is discussed in the section titled <u>Comments to Management</u>. Any response and written corrective action plan to remediate this matter provided by the Clerk are included as an enclosure to this report.

We discussed this comment with the Clerk and we acknowledge the cooperation extended to us by the court during this engagement.

COMMENTS TO MANAGEMENT

We noted the following matter involving internal control and its operation that has led or could lead to the loss of revenues, assets, or otherwise compromise the Clerk's fiscal accountability.

Properly Bill Court Costs

The Clerk and her staff are not properly billing and collecting court appointed attorney fees, the courthouse security fee, the "Tried in Absence" fee and the jail admission fees as required by Sections 19.2-163, 53.1-120, 16.1-69.48:1 and 15.2-1613.1 of the <u>Code of Virginia</u>. The auditor tested 28 cases and noted the following errors in five of these cases.

- In four cases, the Clerk's staff did not bill the defendants for the following:
 - o Court appointed attorney fees totaling \$796
 - o Courthouse security fee totaling \$10
 - o "Tried in Absence" fee totaling \$20
- In one case, the Clerk's staff over-charged a defendant for the jail admission fee totaling \$25.

We recommend the Clerk research all similar cases and make the appropriate corrections. Further, we recommend the Clerk and her staff bill and collect court costs in accordance with the <u>Code of Virginia</u>.
