We are performing a statewide audit of the General District Courts. During our review of this court, we conducted certain audit procedures, as we deemed appropriate.

Management of this court is an important part of the court's accountability, since you are responsible for establishing and maintaining internal controls and complying with applicable laws and regulations. During our review, we noted certain matters that required management's attention and corrective action. These matters included:

## Bill Locality for Public Defender Fees - Repeat Finding

The Clerk did not bill the locality for the use of the Commonwealth's Public Defender in 30 of 67 locality cases. The Clerk is responsible for cases in three local jurisdictions as well as the Commonwealth. When a Public Defender is appointed to represent a defendant charged with a locality offense, the Clerk is required to bill the locality for reimbursement to the Commonwealth.

The Clerk should immediately bill the appropriate localities for the approximately \$3,600 owed for these services. In addition, the Clerk should establish a process to ensure that future locality cases are billed timely.
